County and City of Sacramento Office of Emergency Services Update On Storm Response

Representatives of the City and County of Sacramento continue to monitor the situation closely and are responding to storm related issues. We are between storms and actively responding to customer calls and assessing damage. Although the next set of storms is forecast to be less severe, residents are encouraged to be prepared. Power continues to be restored in the affected areas.

New - Sacramento County: Today, County customers can call to report localized street flooding, downed trees or branches in the roadway: call 875-5656 until 6 p.m. tonight. After hours and on Sunday, customers can call 875-5000.

What residents can do:

- Clear debris from gutters and downspouts
- Drive safely and slowly
- Keep clear of downed powerlines
- Monitor local weather forecasts
- Tie down or properly store outdoor refuse cans, lawn equipment, decorations
- Inventory or create emergency preparedness kits
- Do not remove manhole covers
- Pet owners check to be sure pets are secure and safe

When to call:

- Roadway is blocked- cannot pass through (trees on private property are owners responsibility)
- Localized flooding
- Down power lines
- Gutters/streets flooded making it unsafe to pass or clear

Updates will be provided as necessary.
